RESOLUTION NUMBER 788

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 1993 FOR THE CREATION OF A CAPITAL PROJECTS ACCUMULATION FUND; AND ORDERING THE RECORDING OF SUCH RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, by Resolution Number 772, adopted on the 22nd day of July, 1993, did cause to be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town at a Special Election called and held in and for the Town on the 2nd day of November, 1993, to vote on Proposition 100, the creation of a Capital Projects Accumulation Fund.

WHEREAS, the Town Council did cause notice of the Special Election to be given by the Town Clerk publishing notice thereof in the Arizona Business Gazette newspaper as provided by law, such newspaper published in and having general circulation within said Town, which said notice as so published did specify the place whereat such election was to be held, and the proposition to be voted upon, being now on file and a part of the official records of the Town Council of said Town, and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the total number of ballots cast at said Special Election, as shown by the poll lists, was 1,224.

SECTION 2: That there were two over votes and eight under votes, and were all counted as ineligible votes.

SECTION 3: That the votes cast in favor of a creation of a Capital Projects Accumulation Fund were 826.

SECTION 4: That the votes cast against a creation of a Capital Projects Accumulation Fund were 388.

SECTION 5: That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record that a Capital Projects Accumulation Fund be created.

SECTION 6.: That all orders or resolutions in conflict be and the same are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, and that this resolution be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
