RESOLUTION NUMBER 934

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF PARADISE VALLEY, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA,
DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY
ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 10, 1998.

17 WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, did hold a primary election on
18 the 10th day of March, 1998 for the election of seven Council Members; and

19 WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town
20 Council.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Paradise
22 Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

23 SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said primary election, as shown by the poll
24 lists, was 957 in district 1, 611 in district two for a total of 1,568.

25 SECTION 2. That the total number of rejected ballots equaled four from district one and zero
26 from district two for a total of four.

27 SECTION 3. That the votes cast for the candidates for Council Member were as follows:


