**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF  
THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, MARICOPA  
COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING  
THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD  
FOR TOWN COUNCIL ON MAY 18, 2004.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, held a General Election on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2004 for the non-partisan at-large run-off election for two seats on the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution Number 1060 the election was conducted by “mail ballot”; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to, and have been canvassed by, the Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said General Election, as shown by the poll lists was 3,084.

SECTION 2. That there were a total of fourteen (14) rejected ballots.






