**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF  
THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, MARICOPA  
COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING  
THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD  
FOR TOWN COUNCIL ON MARCH 14, 2006.**


