RESOLUTION NUMBER 1178

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY,
MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING
AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL
ELECTION HELD FOR PROPOSITION 411 ON
NOVEMBER 4, 2008.**

20 WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona,
21 held a Special Election on the 4th day of November, 2008 for Proposition 411, a
22 referendum ordered by petition of the people asking whether to approve or reject
23 Ordinance Number 603, amending the Zoning Ordinance and amending the Zoning
24 Map to provide for the issuance of an amended Special Use Permit for property
25 zoned SUP District (resort) and the rezoning from R43 Cluster Plan to SUP District
26 (resort) to allow for a resort hotel with integrated dwelling units known as The Ritz-
27 Carlton, Paradise Valley located at 7000 E. Lincoln Drive, and

28 WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to, and have been
29 canvassed by, the Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of
32 the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said special election,
2 as shown by the poll lists, was 8,425. And that voter turnout equaled 86%.

5 effect immediately upon its adoption.


