




# Why Photo Enforcement?

- \$80.54      *Base Fine (\$46.07- Town of Paradise Valley General Fund, \$34.47- Redflex Fee)*
- \$20.00      *Court Enhancement Fund (Local Ordinance 12-3-5) to Municipal Court budget for exclusive purpose of enhancing the Court's technology, operations and facilities.*

### 84% State Surcharges

- \$47.26 (47%)      *Criminal Justice Enhancement Fund (A.R.S. 12-116.01A) The state treasurer administers this fund and distributes the monies to provide support to the Arizona automated fingerprint identification system, juvenile corrections for the treatment and rehabilitation of youth, peace officers training, prosecuting attorney's training.*
- \$13.07 (13%)      *Medical Services Enhancement Fund (A.R.S. 12-116.02) The state treasurer administers this fund and distributes the monies to the substance abuse services fund, emergency medical services operating fund, spinal and head injuries trust fund.*

- \$20.00      *Court Enhancement Fund (Local Ordinance 12-3-5) to Municipal Court budget for exclusive purpose of enhancing the Court's technology, operations and facilities.*

### 84% State Surcharges

- \$58.75 (47%)      *Criminal Justice Enhancement Fund (A.R.S. 12-116.01A) The state treasurer administers this fund and distributes the monies to provide support to the Arizona automated fingerprint identification system, juvenile corrections for the treatment and rehabilitation of youth, peace officers training, prosecuting attorney's training.*
- \$16.25 (13%)      *Medical Services Enhancement Fund (A.R.S. 12-116.02) The state treasurer administers this fund and distributes the monies to the substance abuse services fund, emergency medical services operating fund, spinal and head injuries trust fund.*
