Residential Burglary Activity 2015-6454

On April 4th, 2015 at about 7:50 pm, officers were dispatched to the 5100 block of East Beryl Ave. for a residential burglar alarm. While checking the residence, another house alarm was heard by the officers who requested additional officers. The source of the 2nd alarm was located in the 5000 block of East Beryl Ave. where officers located a damaged door in the rear of the property. It appeared someone had attempted to force the door but was unsuccessful and did not gain entry. Back at the house in the 5100 block, officers located an unsecured rear patio door. Officers checked the interior of the residence and secured the property when it didn't appear anything was missing. A canvass was done of the area looking for the perpetrator(s) of the damaged door. Sometime later during that canvass, the owners of the residence in the 5100 block of Beryl arrived home and reported that some jewelry had in fact been taken. Also, during the canvass a homeowner in the 4900 block of East Beryl called after spotting an unidentified male in their back yard. This individual was not located during a search of the area.
