Vehicle Burglary Arrest 2008-14070

In October of 2008 Paradise Valley Officers responded to a vehicle burglary in the 5400 block of Lincoln Dr. The victim had reported that her vehicle window had been smashed and three (3) suitcases were removed. Several evidentiary items were located inside the vehicle and collected by responding officers. These items were later submitted to the Arizona Department of Public Safety Crime Lab for analysis.


In April of this year, Paradise Valley Detectives received a lab report from the DPS Crime Lab indicating they had located DNA on one of the items submitted. That DNA sample was compared to those in Arizona's DNA Indexing System and a match was received.

With this information, detectives identified Dominick J. Hurley as a suspect. Detectives were eventually able to track down Mr. Hurley who is currently a resident of the Arizona Department of Corrections' Lewis facility where he is serving out a 9 ½ year sentence for Fraud and Burglary.

The Criminal Investigations Unit has therefore submitted the case to the Maricopa County Attorney's Office for a charge of Burglary-3rd Degree. This is the second burglary case in Paradise Valley recently resolved with the use of DNA evidence.
