Paradise Valley Police Arrest 1 for Criminal Trespass #2016-10779

Paradise Valley, Arizona - (April 14, 2016) At approximately 3:30 p.m. Paradise Valley Police were called to the 7800 block of N. Mockingbird Ln. for a possible burglary in progress. The caller, a realtor, indicated that there was an individual in the house he was closing up after a private showing. When confronted by the caller, the suspect left the residence. With the description provided by the caller, Paradise Valley Police quickly located the subject within a block of the residence and detained him. It was at that time that the caller was able to positively identify the subject as the individual he found within the house that was for sale. At that time, Matthew J. Goins of Phoenix was taken into custody. Mr. Goins was charged with 1 count of Criminal Trespass and 1 count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia which he had in his possession at the time of his arrest. After processing, Mr. Goins was released on his own recognizance after being given a court date later this month.


