Arrest on Theft and Possession of Stolen Property Suspect 2016-26915

On 09-02-16 Paradise Valley Police Officer Keller stopped a vehicle on a traffic stop for driving on expired registration. Once stopped, the driver was identified as Latisha Aguilar W/F, 35 years of age, who resides in Phoenix. A records check revealed Ms. Aguilar had a suspended driver's license. Ms. Aguilar was placed under arrest and her car was impounded due to her driving on the suspended license.

An inventory search of the car revealed two packages with different addresses in Phoenix and one with a address in Paradise Valley that had just been delivered. Pending a follow up investigation, Ms. Aguilar will be charges with theft, possession of stolen property and she will be referred to the Postal Inspector for possible mail theft charges.
