

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1266

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, MARICOPA COUNTY,
ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS
OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD FOR PROPOSITION
454 ON NOVEMBER 6, 2012**

WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, held a Special Election on the 6th day of November, 2012 for Proposition 454, regarding the ratification or rejection of Ordinance Number 652 amending the Town Code by requiring the mayor of the Town of Paradise Valley to be selected by the Town Council rather than directly elected by the voters; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution Number 1257 the election was consolidated with the Maricopa County Election ballot; and,

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to, and have been canvassed by, the Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of valid ballots cast at said election, as shown by the poll lists, was 8,503;

SECTION 2. That the total number of rejected ballots was 66;

SECTION 3. That the total number of votes cast by precinct for Proposition 454, regarding the direct election of the mayor, were as follows:
