False alarms annual cost \$187,837.64

16% increase in false alarms in 2016

False alarms require two officers

Causes of false alarms: - alarm system failure or user error

Potential Solutions:

Enforcement, Permitting, Online Alarm education, address common causes to eliminate false alarms, Alarm company permitting at install, Third party enforcement. ex.CryWolf

Outreach to vendors to assist, getting good contact information through permitting process
