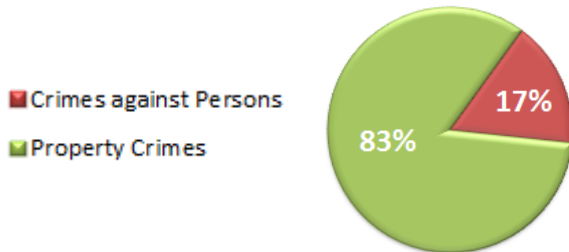
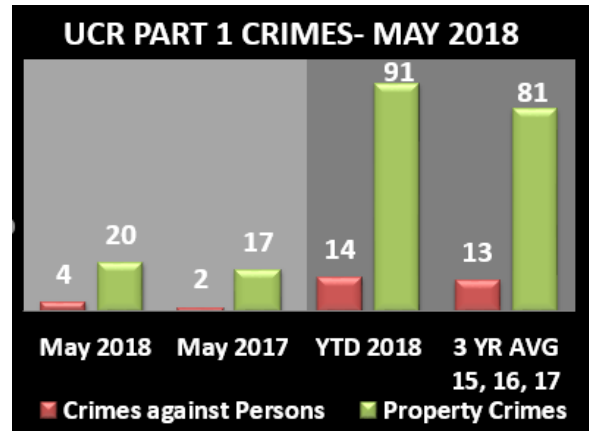


**Part 1 Crimes include: Crimes against Persons & Property crimes.**

- Property crimes includes: burglary, theft, motor vehicle theft and arson.

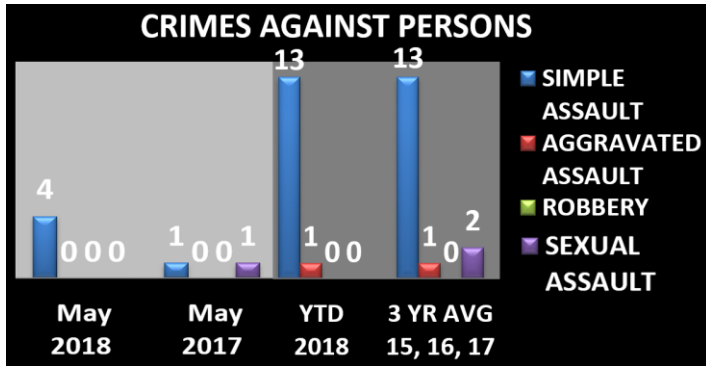
In May, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported **24** Part 1 Crimes to the FBI.

- There were **4** crimes against persons and **20** property crimes.



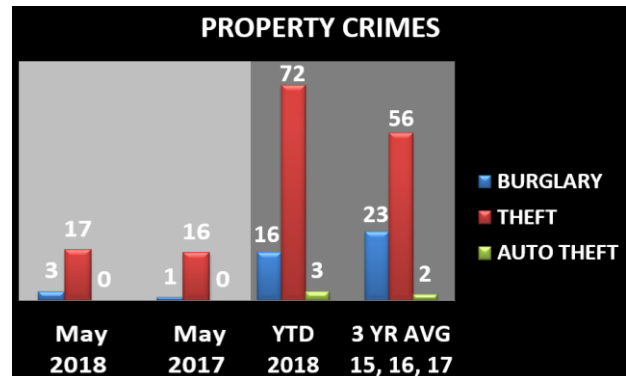
### CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

In May, there were **4** simple assault reported. There were no homicides, sexual assaults, aggravated assaults or robberies.

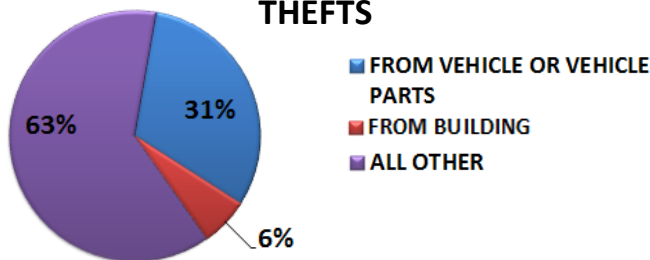


### PROPERTY CRIMES

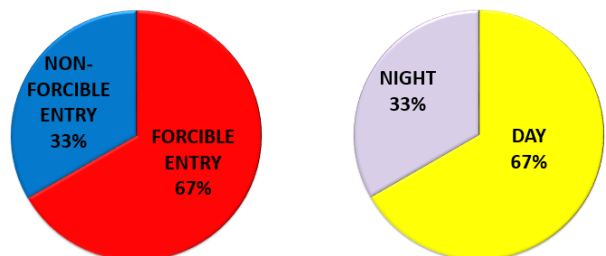

### RESIDENTIAL BURGLARIES





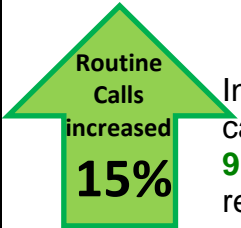

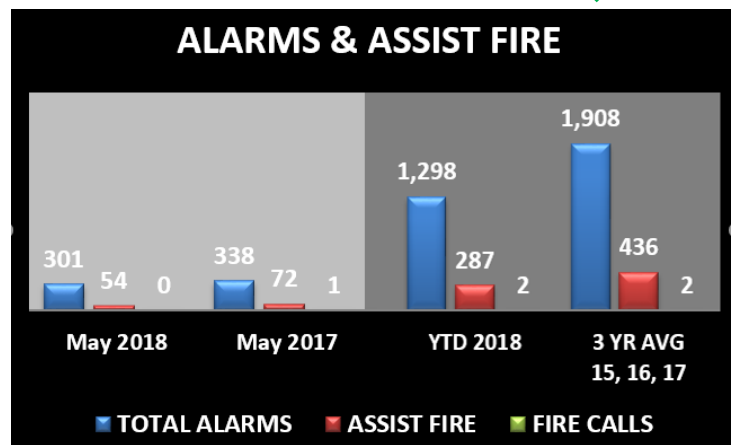
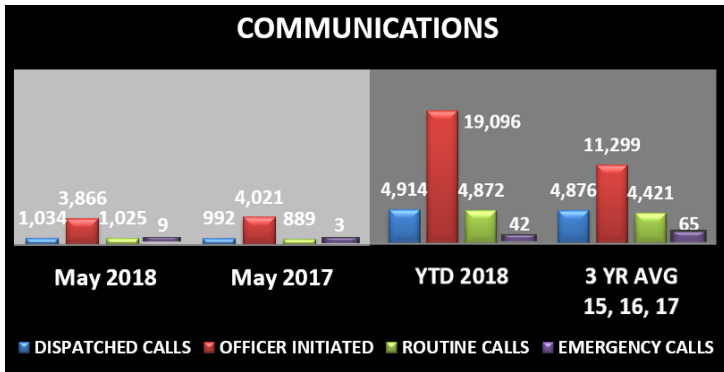


### COMMUNICATIONS



In May, there were **1,025** routine calls, **1,034** dispatched calls, and **9** emergency calls. The average response time for priority one calls was **3:00**.

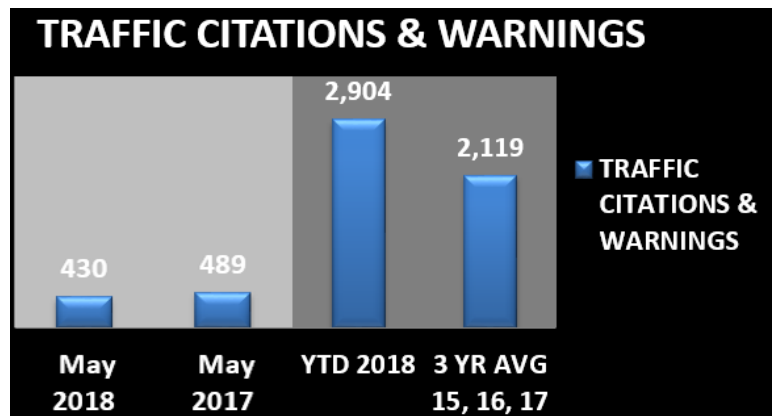
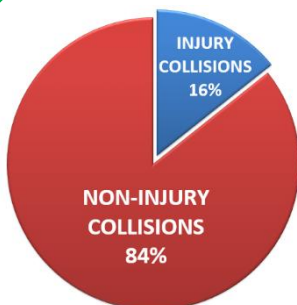
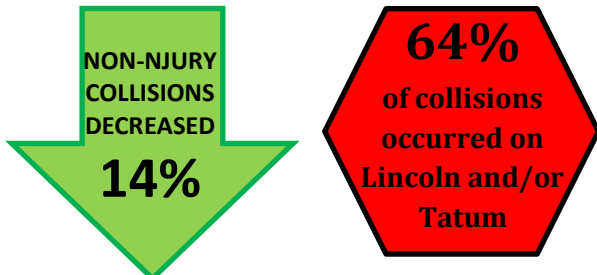
In May, there were **301** alarms. Officers assisted Phoenix Fire **54** times in May. There were no Fire calls in May.
