



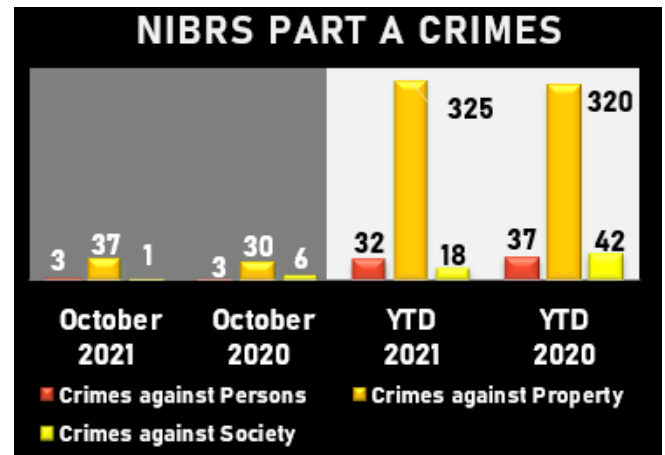
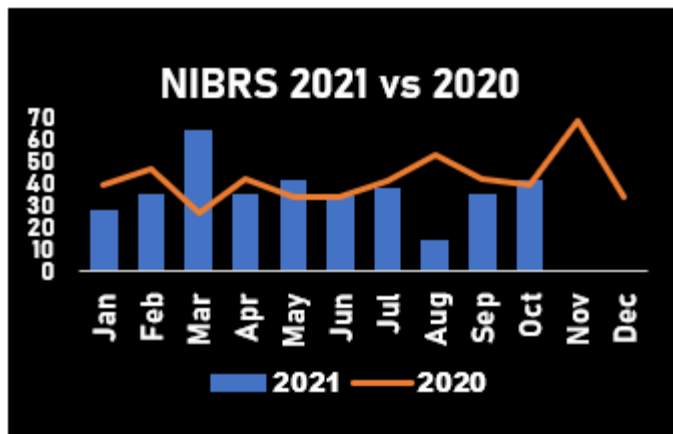

January 1, 2021, the FBI has retired the UCR Summary Reporting System (SRS) and transitioned to National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). The FBI's transition to a NIBRS only data collection will improve the nations crime data through rich details and greater specificity of offenses. Due to this change Paradise Valley Police will compare one-year data versus three-year data.

- NIBRS include Crimes against Persons, Property & Society crimes.
 - NIBRS collects data from 52 offenses, plus 10 additional offenses for which only arrests are reported.
- In October, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported 41 crimes to the FBI.
 - There were 3 crimes against persons, 37 property crimes and 1 crime against society.



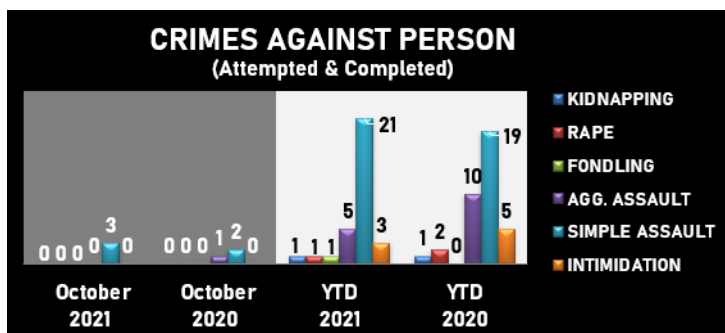
CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons, e.g., murder, rape, and assault, are those whose victims are always individuals.

Simple Assaults decreased

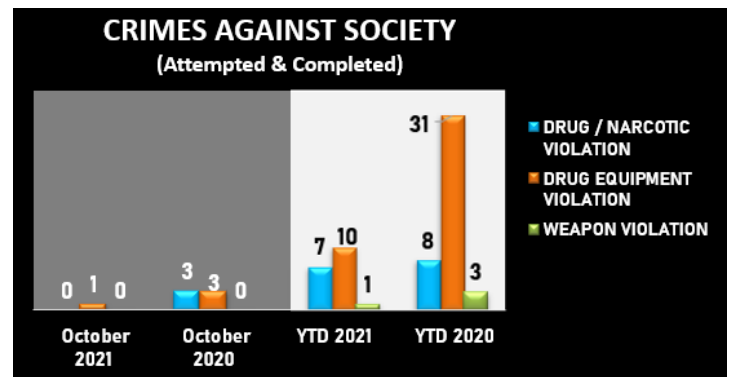
In October, persons crimes consisted of 3 simple assault cases.



CRIMES AGAINST SOCIETY

Crimes Against Society, e.g., gambling, prostitution, and drug violations; they are typically crimes in which property is not the object.

In October, society crimes consisted of 1 drug equipment violation.

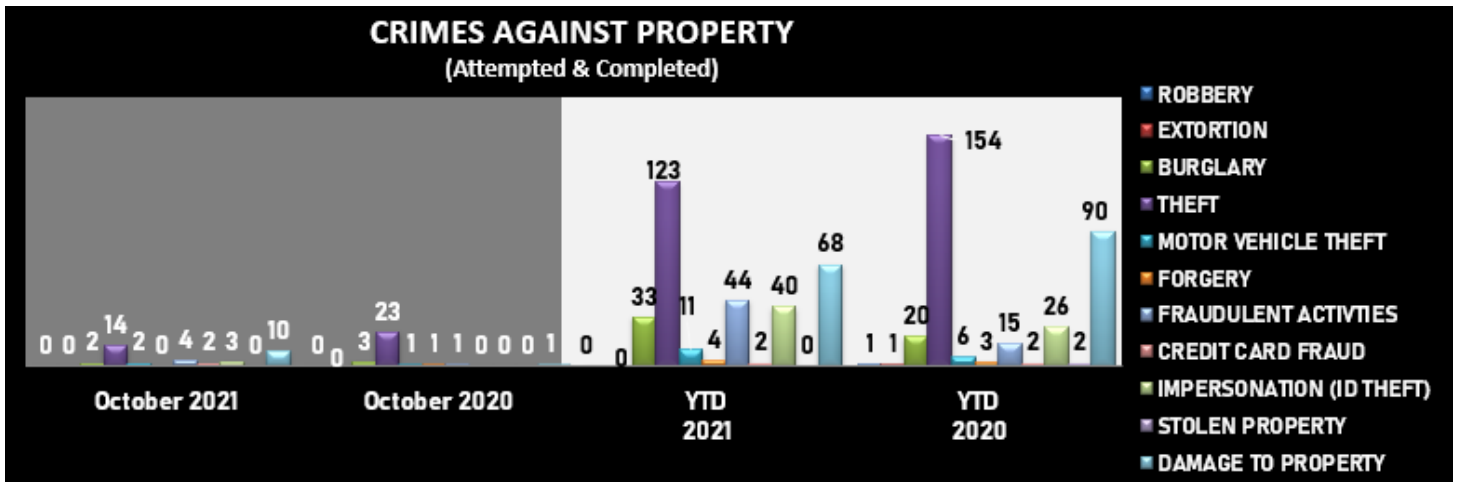

CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

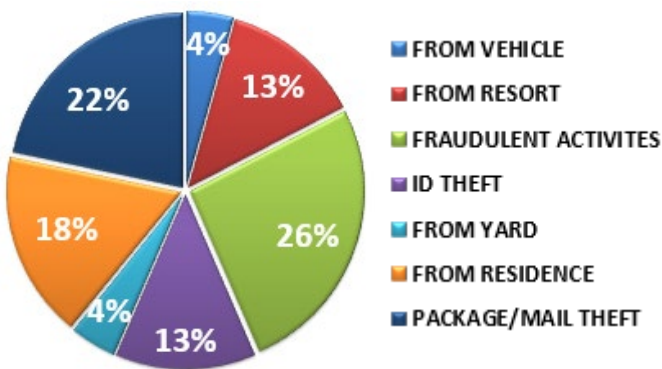
Crimes Against Property, e.g., robbery, bribery, and burglary, is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit.

In October, property crimes consisted of 2 burglaries, 14 thefts, 2 motor vehicle thefts, 4 fraudulent activities, 2 credit card fraud, 3 impersonations (ID theft) and 10 property damage cases.

Priority 1 Calls decreased

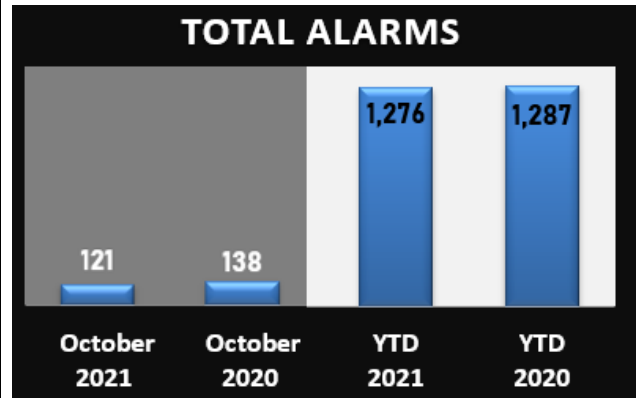
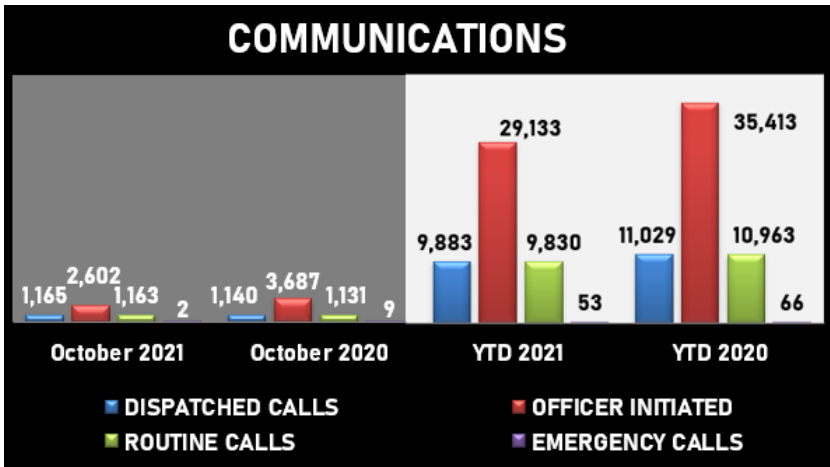

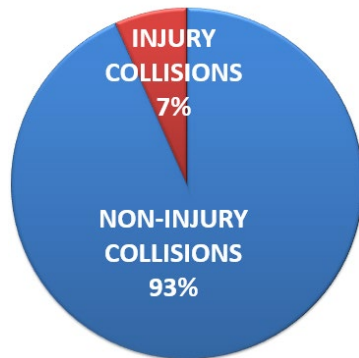
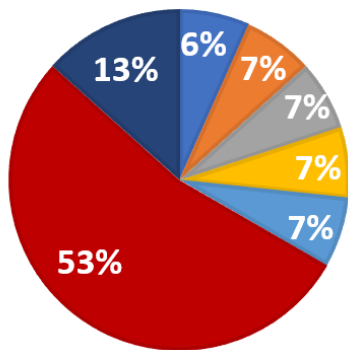
Injury Collisions decreased

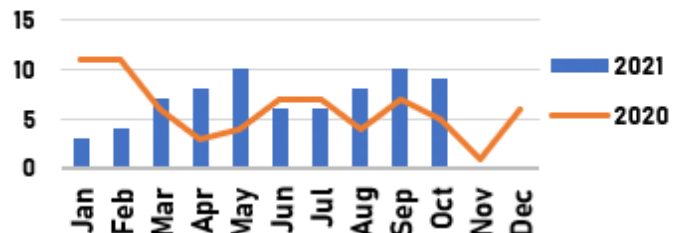
In October, there were **14** non-injury collisions and **1** injury collisions.
