RESOLUTION NUMBER 941

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN  
OF PARADISE VALLEY, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA,  
DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL  
ELECTION HELD ON MAY 19, 1998.

WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, did hold a general election on  
the 19th day of May, 1998 to decide proposition 400; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town  
Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Paradise  
Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said general election, as shown by the poll  
lists, was 369 in district one, and 296 in district two for a total of 665.

SECTION 2. That the total number of rejected ballots equaled 17 from district one and 14 from  
district two for a total of 31.

SECTION 3. That the votes cast for Proposition 400 were as follows:




