Scottsdale woman faces criminal charges for fraudulent schemes and artifices, theft, and forgeries

Case #2022-33720

On 11/03/2022 at 10:56 AM, the Paradise Valley Police Department was dispatched to a report of a series of forgeries that occurred at the 7100 block of N Tatum Blvd. The patrol officer completed a thorough on-scene investigation, after which the case was forwarded to the Criminal Investigation Unit (CIU) for further follow-up. The detective identified and confirmed the investigative lead based on financial records and surveillance videos. On Monday, December 19, 2022, **Jana Lyn O'Brien** (51 y/o), of Scottsdale, AZ, self-surrendered to the Paradise Valley Police Department for the following felony charges: one count of Fraudulent Schemes and Artifices, one count of Theft, and thirteen counts of Forgery. O'Brien was arrested and booked into the county jail pending her initial court appearance with the Maricopa County Superior Court.
