An individual who knowingly falsifies his certificate for a document under these provisions is guilty of a class 6 felony. Further, any person who obtains a public record for a noncommercial purpose and uses or knowingly allows the use of such public record for a commercial purpose or who obtains a public record for a commercial purpose and uses or knowingly allows the use of such public record for a different commercial purpose or who obtains a public record from anyone other than the custodian of such records and uses them for a commercial purpose shall be liable to the state or the political subdivision for the amount of three times the actual damages if it can be shown that the public record would not have been provided had the commercial purpose or actual use been stated at the time of obtaining the records.

The Paradise Valley Police Department may assess a fee for records requested for a commercial purpose to cover the following: 1) a portion of the cost to the Town of obtaining the original or copies of the documents; 2) a reasonable fee for the cost of time, equipment and personnel in producing such reproduction; and 3) the value of the reproduction on the commercial market. Among other costs, the Paradise Valley Police Department may count the time personnel expended to retrieve the record, transportation, the actual cost to the Paradise Valley Police Department for special equipment or processing required in preparing the record for release, among other factors (A.R.S. § 39-121.03A)
