Aggravated Assault Against Law Enforcement Case #2021-17501



Calista Marie Kistler, Age 20, of Glendale

On 05/13/2021 at 2340 hours, officers with The Paradise Valley Police Department were dispatched to the area of North Tatum Blvd & East Caida Del Sol regarding an intoxicated subject in the roadway and in distress. Upon arrival, Ms. Kistler was contacted and became aggressive with subjects attempting to assist her, as well as law enforcement. Ms. Kistler failed to provide truthful information to law enforcement and assaulted three officers during her arrest. Ms. Kistler was booked into the Maricopa County Jail for three counts of Aggravated Assault – Law Enforcement, one count of Failure to Provide Truthful Name When Detained, and one count of Minor in Consumption.
